The TASO Chapter agrees to the following conditions-

- Each TASO member certifies annually that they have not been convicted of a state or federal felony misdemeanor or felony offense (except for minor traffic offenses punishable by fine only). The completed membership forms are on file with the state TASO office.
- Each official is required to attend a rules clinic annually in order to be familiar with the latest rules for their sport, either at the state meeting, regional clinics or local chapter meeting.
- The chapter will require each official annually to complete TAPPS SCOPE prior to officiating TAPPS games by viewing the video at a scheduled chapter meeting.
- The chapter provides schools with a list of the names of the officials for each game as soon as possible prior to the game date and no later than one week before the scheduled game (replacements excluded).
- The chapter will not schedule officials with the same school more than 3 times in a year (except for tournament games that do not count towards the game limit).
- The chapter officials will notify the TAPPS office within 24 hours of any player/coach ejection or other incidents which in the officials' opinion should be noted to TAPPS.
- A TAPPS varsity head coach may file a grievance with the chapter concerning an official by contacting the chapter president or the TASO State Office. The Chapter will have a hearing in accordance with the chapter by-laws and operating procedures. A written report of the hearing can be made available to the TAPPS coach, TAPPS schools and TAPPS upon request.
- The chapter has a list on file of all TAPPS schools that they have a contract with for the upcoming season.
- Fees for services shall be negotiated and contracted with each individual TAPPS school on a flat rate basis that includes mileage. TAPPS member schools may use the suggested fee schedules in the TAPPS By-Laws to negotiate a fee schedule that they may be willing to pay, but are not bound by that fee schedule.
